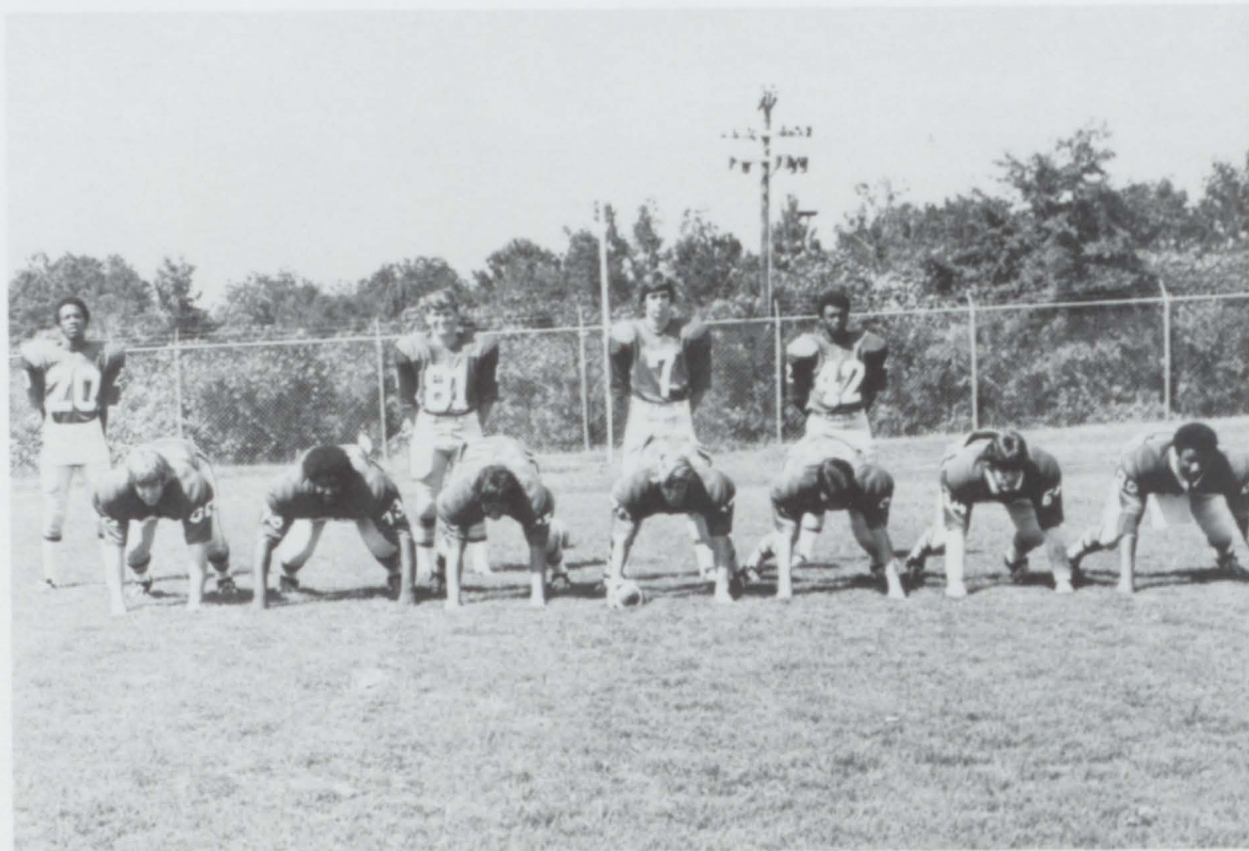
## AND COACHES 1978-1979

In the Luverne vs. Elba game in Luverne, a disasterous moment was thrown upon the Tigers. Luverne was shutout 27-0. Daleville was the next on the Tigers list. The Tigers downed Daleville 23-6. Brantley was the next attack for the TIGERS. To end 5 years of frustration, the Tigers won 13-6. Jackson, Threat, and Pat Smith gave Luverne its 13. In the home game against HHHS, Jesse Dixon, Threat, Jackson, and Bo Dixon along with Smith's extra point set up a 27-9 victory. Air was the story of success when Luverne downed Samson 27-20.
