Summer Reading Rules

Earn prizes for 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30 points reading!

Earn 1 point—books less than 100 pages ★

Earn 2 points—books 100 pages or more ★★

Earn 1 point for completing a craft/project ★

Earn 2 points for completing a borrow on hoopla or attending a program/event. ★★

Earn 1 points for reading to a younger child 15 minutes ★

1. The summer reading program is open for all ages. Adult participants will be entered to win gift cards/prizes. **NOTE: Photographs taken may be used to promote library activities on our website, social media pages, and other communications.**
2. Children 5 years or older must have their own library card. A parent/guardian must sign for a child to obtain a library card for all children age 16 or younger.
3. Children under 5 may use their parent/guardians card.
4. Children under 10 must have a parent or guardian present.
5. Reading logs may be submitted the library to document goals and earn prizes.
6. Books used for summer reading points must be checked out from the Hobson City Public Library, or from your hoopla account and recorded in the reading log.
7. The library will give out prizes in exchange for specific amounts of points earned. Prizes are limited to first come, first served.
